### **Bring Your Own Device (B. Y. O. D.) Agreement**

HCSPS has embraced a Bring Your Own Technology/Device approach to enhance student learning experiences and the use of technology for our students and teachers.

Electronic devices are used to promote authentic learning, research and positive communication. We support our students to become digitally responsible citizens.

**Please review and sign the B. Y. O. D. agreement between teachers, parents, and students of HCSPS. No student will be permitted to use a personal technology device until the agreement is signed and returned. A device is defined as any technology (Ipad, Ipod, tablet etc) that students would like to use to facilitate word processing, capturing video and recording audio, accessing the internet, and processing information.**

Students participating in the B. Y. O. D. must adhere to the Acceptable Use Policy of Hallett Cove South Primary School. Please read the following statements carefully:

1. Students take full responsibility for their devices. The school is NOT responsible for security of personal technology, including damage, breakage or theft. Families are also responsible for the insurance of personal devices. Protective casings and personal engraving of devices are strongly encouraged. Personal devices cannot be left before or after school hours.
2. Devices cannot be used outside the classroom, unless otherwise directed by the teacher.
3. Devices will be used under direct supervision of a teacher for educational purposes only. Students must immediately comply with teachers' requests to shut down devices or close the screen. Devices must be in silent mode and put away when asked by the teacher.
4. Students are not permitted to transmit or post photographic images/videos of any person at school on public and/or social networks. Students are not permitted to bypass or hack into any hardware or software systems. No personal information about self or others is to be revealed.
5. Personal devices must be charged prior to bringing them to school and run off their own batteries while at school.
6. To ensure appropriate network filters, students will only use the BYOD wireless connection in school and 3G and 4G access will be turned off during school hours. This will ensure filtering occurs to avoid access to offensive or inappropriate content.
7. HCSPS reserves the right to collect and examine any device if there is reason to believe that there has been a violation of the policy regarding inappropriate use or content. Students must immediately report any inappropriate behavior or content to the teacher.
8. Printing from personal devices will not be permitted at school.
9. Students will not share their personal devices with other students. Only the student that brings the device may use the device. Personal log in details will be kept secure.
10. Students need to be aware that consequences will be applied as per the Student Behavior Management Procedures if any of the above are violated and could include – network lock out, revoke permission to bring the device to school, suspension, police notification etc. Internet activity is recorded and may be used in investigations.
